

H1N1 Flu Clinics in our area

Currently all clinics are limited to those considered at highest risk of flu complications. The targeted groups to receive the vaccine include:

- Pregnant Women
- Healthcare workers with Direct Patient Contact
- Children and young adults aged 6 months through 24 years of age.
- Individuals who live with or care for infants less than 6 months of age.
- Adults 25-64 years of age with underlying medical conditions.

The following conditions are an “underlying medical condition” that makes a person eligible for vaccination:

- Cancer
- Blood disorders (including sickle cell disease)
- Chronic lung disease [such as asthma or chronic obstructive pulmonary disease (COPD)]
- Diabetes
- Heart disease
- Kidney disorders
- Liver disorders
- Neurological disorders (such as epilepsy, cerebral palsy, brain or spinal cord injuries, moderate to profound intellectual disability [mental retardation] or developmental delay)
- Neuromuscular disorders (such as muscular dystrophy and multiple sclerosis)
- Weakened immune systems (such as people with HIV or AIDS or who are on medications that weaken the immune system)
