

LEA notification regarding asbestos in Bangor Public Schools

Dear Parents, Guardians, and Staff of Bangor Public Schools:

In December of 2012, Villa Environmental Consultants Inc. conducted our 3 year asbestos re-inspection, following federal guidelines.

All of the asbestos containing material was removed from the South Walnut Elementary building during the recent renovation project. The large majority of the asbestos containing materials was removed from the remaining district buildings in 2005. The existing asbestos contained material is being maintained in accordance with Environmental Protection Agency Guidelines.

According to the re-inspection documentation, Bangor Public Schools are in good standing and is continuing with a sound asbestos management plan.
