



Legislators visit Bangor School Based Health Center

On Friday, March 24, Senator Tonya Schuitmaker and Representative Beth Griffin visited Bangor chool Based Health Center, operated by Van Buren Community Mental Health. The legisl were welcomed by health center staff, school administrators and several middle and high school students. After a tour of the clinic, the students, ranging in ages from 13 to 18, shared their views about the benefits of having a health center in the school. Some of the benefits talked about included convenience and ease of access to health care services; missing less school time for medical appointments; trustworthy and caring staff; learning about various aspects of being a healthy teen; getting assistance with a variety of common teen issues, including receiving counseling; services available regardless of insurance or ability to pay; privacy and confidentiality of services.

The legislators spent almost an hour touring the clinic and talking with the students. The students expressed their views in a very articulate and mature manner – a very positive representation of the young people we work with! The adults were very impressed with these young people and how well they expressed their thoughts and feelings.

The Bangor School Based Health Center is located inside Bangor Middle School, and serves youth ages 10 to 21. Primary care services provided include comprehensive physicals, immunizations, care of acute and chronic illness, health education and risk assessment, mental health counseling and help with Medicaid enrollment. The clinic is staffed with a family nurse practitioner, Katherine Radakovich; certified medical assistant, Corie Barchett; licensed clinical social worker, Karen Riffer-Reinert; billing specialist, Joyce Doty; and clinic coordinator, Becky Fatzinger. Services are provided, with parent/guardian consent for those under 18, regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. Same or next day appointments are often available; services are provided year round, including
