

Sample K-5 Daily Teacher Workflow

Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday:

- Deliver new in-person content each in-person day regardless of cohort present
- Record relevant direct instruction/content delivery
- Document 2-way communications for in-person students
- End of day: Post new presented content online, make contacts with virtual students, enter virtual student attendance from previous day

Wednesday

- 1 hour of prep time, enter attendance from previous day
- 1 hour of grade level collaboration
 - o Each grade level teacher could create unique content and share between teachers
 - 2-3 hours of communication with virtual students
 - o Document two-way communications with remote students
- 1-2 hours of content creation and/or delivery/PLCs/meetings

Sample 6-12 Daily Teacher Workflow

In-person Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday:

- Deliver engaging hands-on application of content
- Record any relevant direct instruction/content delivery
- Provide one-on-one assistance for online content
- · Document 2-way communications for in-person students
- · End of day: Post new presented content online, make contacts with virtual students, enter virtual student attendance from previous day
- Wednesday
- 1 hour of prep time
- 1 hour of grade level/content level collaboration
- 2-3 hours of communication with remote students
 - · Document two-way communications with remote students, enter attendance from previous day
- 1-2 hours of content creation and/or delivery/PLCs/meetings

Live: All subjects

Online: Students at home follow same pace

Online: Present content online for all students and support students who need extra help
