SCHOOL BOND PROPOSAL

On Tuesday, May 2, 2023, our community will vote on a school bond proposal for Bangor Public Schools.

If approved by voters, this bond will provide \$7,250,000 for district-wide improvements with **no tax rate increase** over the current tax rate. The proposed projects focus on two areas: Safety and Educational Improvements.

Safety

- Adding a secure building entrances at the Middle & High School
- Classroom door hardware upgrades district-wide
- Access Control Improvements district-wide
- Parking lot expansion and re-configuration
- Restroom renovations and additional staff restrooms at the Middle & High School
- South Walnut playground improvements

Educational Improvements

- New educational technology district-wide to enhance learning
- At the Middle School & High School:
 - Media Center renovations
 - · STEM Lab renovations
 - · New educational technology to enhance learning
 - · Classroom furniture & equipment upgrades
 - · Classroom flooring selective replacements
 - · Cafeteria servery improvements
