Michigan State High School Clay Target League's 2023 State Tournament

On Saturday, June 17th, the Bangor Vikings Trap Team traveled to Mason, Michigan to the Michigan Trapshooting Association grounds for the 2023 State Tournament. With 9 members of the team in attendance, competing with 1,154 other trapshooters from around the state, the Bangor Vikings Trap Team held their own. It was an emotional day for everyone involved, with multiple personal best scores achieved for multiple shooters. The team had two first-time 25 straight rounds completed. Each of these scores was earned by the shooter. Through their skill and dedication, they all performed admirably. Notable mentions:
