Dear Bangor Public Schools Parents, Staff and Community members:

We have received notification from a staff member and/or the Van Buren Cass County Health Department that 1 staff member associated with the South Walnut Elementary, has tested positive for COVID-19. The staff member first developed symptoms on Monday, November 30th, 2020, and the staff members last day on campus was Nov. 25th, 2020. While we must protect the privacy of the persons involved, we believe it is best to communicate transparently with you, so that you can make well-informed decisions for your family.

There is nothing more important to Bangor Public Schools than the safety and health of our students, our staff and their families. We are working directly with county health officials to address this situation.

The Local County Health Department has recommended we share the following information:

It is important to remember the children are greatly influenced by the reactions of adults when facing difficult circumstances. We encourage everyone to remain calm and to be respectful to those affected.
